PHYSICAL CHARACTERISTICS

Trunk: The trunk is hollow, straight and smooth.

coating.

It is native to Bangladesh, India, Srilanka, South-East Asia and to the province of Yunnan in Southern China.

CULTIVATION AND USES

The leaves of *Bambusa bambos* was used for the treatment of heart problems and malaria. It is also boiled and used in bath to ease fever. Common bamboo is used for light construction. Good source of fibre for paper making. Bamboo is used for building materials as a food source and as a raw product. Depicted often in arts such as in bamboo painting.

Fastest growing plant with edible shoots. It is strong and durable. It prevents soil erosion.
