## PHYSICAL CHARACTERISTICS

The tree can grow up to 20-40 feet tall.

Trunk: slender, yellow and smooth.

Leaves: Pinnate, yellow-green to golden colour, 6-10 ft

long.

Flower: Small and yellow, male and female flowers are separate.

**Fruit**: Oval shaped, 1-2 cm long, yellowish - green to brown in colour.

### **DISTRIBUTION AND HABITAT**

Golden pane Palm originated in Madagascar naturally growing alongside streams and thickets.

## **CULTIVATION AND USES**

It is decorative, fast growing and hardly tropical, ideal for creating height clearance indoors. Used as ornamental plants in gardens, landscapes and indoor spaces, etc.

#### **INTERESTING FACTS**

The golden cane palm is a clustering palm, meaning it grows in a clump with multiple stems.
