INTRODUCTION

St. Johns College Anchal is one of the Malankara Syrian Catholic colleges established and administered by the Major Archdiocese of Trivandrum. This is the fruit of the vision of late Archbishop Most. Rev. Dr. Benedict Mar Gregorios and currently flourishes under the patronage of His Beatitude Moran Mor Baselios Cardinal Cleemis Catholicos.

The college, affiliated to the University of Kerala, was started in 1964 with pre-degree courses and upgraded successively with UG and PG courses. There are currently 10 UG and 4 PG programmes in Arts, Science and Commerce. The teaching staff strength is 74 with 46 permanent staff and 28 guest lectures. There are 23 permanent Administrative staff and 10 others to help the daily functioning of the college. Altogether there are 1300 students among them 70% are women.

In 2015, the college was re-accredited with "A" grade by NAAC. We earnestly dedicate ourselves to jump into the higher steps to achieve superior aspirations utilizing all possible resources for better education and to fulfill the mission and vision of the college.

The college advances into the higher realm of STAR College scheme (a grant of 47 lakh) by DBT, Ministry of Science and Technology, Government of India.

The college also bagged the DST-FIST Recognition in 2016, i.e., a grant of 1.1 cr. is sanctioned for 5 years to the science departments to provide ample opportunities to acquire some major research activities of the college and thereby improve quality of education.

The College also got enlisted in the RUSA infrastructure fund list in 2018.(-a grant of 2 Cr. Sanctioned for the infrastructural development in collaboration with the management with a share of 20%.)

The institution has entered its third cycle of accreditation and the Johnsian fraternity is working effortlessly for the same. The IQAC of St John's College, Anchal was established in 1-06-2005. This year the college is moving for the third cycle of NAAC reaccreditation. At present the college has been accredited with 'A' grade (grade point 3.01), in cycle 2. Challenges

- Lack of adequate campus placements.
- Lack of interest for higher studies.
- Lack of permanent faculty in many of the departments.
- Lack of Stadium and furnished courts for sports activities.
- Unnecessary intervention of the political students union in day today affairs.
- Infrastructural development is a major challenge i.e, lack of sufficient classrooms, administrative block, Lab facilities etc.

The 'A' grade accreditation has helped the college in procuring funds like DBT Star College Scheme and DST FIST, which has been utilized to upgrade labs and this has helped in raising the college to a research centre (Dept. of Chemistry). There is a separate office for IQAC and it is need of AC by the time of NAAC peer team visit probably by March first week. Equipmentsused have been the same that is in use for the last 5 years. Since the last visit in March 2015 there have not been any purchases pertaining to IQAC. There is one computer but it requires two systems. There is internet connectivity and centralized UPS is extended to the IQAC office. The presence of proper office furniture is also a requisite.
