• Training Programme on officemanagement for Non-Teaching Staff



After Christmas holidays, the college reopened on 03 January 2023.




• ED Club Inauguration

• Inspection from University of Kerala for new course


The Kerala Government vide order G.O. (Ms.) No.582/2023/HEDN dated 19.10.2023 has granted concurrence to convert M.A Public Administration Programme to M.A Political Science (Aided) programme in St. John's College, Anchal. In this regard, the Syndicate of the University of Kerala has decided to conduct an inspection in the college on 02.02.2024, 11 a.m. by a team including a subject expert to verify the instructional facilities made available for starting MA Political Science Programme from the academic year 2024-25 onwards.

The inspection team reached the college by 11.15 am on 02.02.2024. The team consisted of Mr.R. Rajesh, Member of Kerala University Syndicate and former M.L.A from the Mavelikkara constituency, and Dr. Josukutty C. A, Professor of Political Science, University of Kerala. The team was received by the faculty members of Department of Political Science and Public Administration and proceeded to the Principal's chamber for discussions. After verifying the official records, the team moved to the college library to check the facilities.

The team has verified the list of books, numbering more than 3000, that comes under the various fields in Political Science produced by the librarian. 
• Kollam District Athletic Championship 2023


Poster Making Competition


Anchal, Indian Bank Anchal and Nehru Yuva Kendra Kollam. It was the second phase programme conducted in Kollam District.

Kanal Fest 2023


