



### **SCHOLARSHIP / ENDOWMENTS POLICY**

St John's College, Anchal has formulated a policy on the disbursement of the Scholarships/Free-ships/Endowments for students. A number of scholarships instituted by the State and Central Governments, UGC, Higher Education Council, Management, Parent Teacher Association, Old Students Association, various organizations and others are being distributed through the College. Students shall avail maximum benefit out of it applying for the same in its due time and in the prescribed format countersigned by the Principal.

## The Policy

- 1. Scholarship selection committee is constituted every year by the principal of the college with a faculty member as the Convener and members from both teaching and non-teaching staff.
- 2. The scholarship committee shall be authorized to scrutinize the applications based on defined criteria by the scholarship selection committee in case of Institutional Scholarships of the college and as per the respective guidelines in case of those instituted by Government agencies.
- 3. The convener of the scholarship committee shall serve as the Nodal officer of the college for all Government Scholarship Schemes.
- 4. The Scholarship Committee shall communicate to the selected candidates from each department regarding the scholarships as per notification and ensures that the students apply for the same.










- 5. The scholarship committee and the selected candidates will have the responsibility to assist the students in filling the application and filing it well in advance.
- 6. The applications for institutional scholarship should be forwarded by the Head of the Department.
- Equal distribution of scholarships among all Departments is ensured by the 7. Scholarship Committee.
- 8. It is mandatory that the students applying for scholarship should intimate it to the Head of the Department, Nodal Officer of the College and the Principal before applying for the same.
- 9. Grievances, if any related to the application, selection and distribution shall be under the purview of the Student Grievances Redressal Cell and Scholarship Committee.
- 10. The decision of the Scholarship Committee shall be final.











#### **GUIDELINES FOR NATIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS**

- 1. INSPIRE SCHOLARSHIP: "Innovation in Science Pursuit for Inspired Research (INSPIRE)" is an innovative programme sponsored and managed by the Department of Science & Technology for attraction of talent to Science. The basic objective of INSPIRE is to communicate to the youth of the country the excitements of creative pursuit of science, attract talent to the study of science at an early age and thus build the required critical human resource pool for strengthening and expanding the Science & Technology system and R & D base. A striking feature of the programme is that it does not believe in conducting competitive exams for identification of talent at any level. It believes in and relies on the efficacy of the existing educational structure for identification of talent. This scholarship is for science stream students which begins from undergraduate programme and can continue the scholarship to postgraduate and research programme with an yearly allowance of 60,000/- to 1,20,000/- . - 2. CENTRAL SECTOR POST METRIC SCHOLARSHIP: The objective of the scheme is to appreciably increase the Gross Enrolment Ratio of SC students in higher education with a focus on those from the poorest households, by providing financial assistance at post-matriculation or post-secondary stage to enable them to complete their education. These scholarships are available for studies in India only and the awardees are selected by the State Government/Union Territory to which the applicant actually belongs (i.e. the State/UT in which permanently settled or domiciled, as per the terms of domicile decided by the

- **3. SOUTH INDIAN BANK SCHOLARSHIP:** To provide educational opportunities among the disabled Students of Kerala, the South Indian bank limited has launched a South India Bank Scholarship. Under this scheme, financial assistance will be provided to disabled students to continue their higher education. - **4. JUNIOR RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP:** The objective of the JRF scheme is to provide opportunities to NET JRF qualified candidates to undertake advanced studies and research leading to M.Phil/Ph.D. Degrees in Humanities and science.

Target Group: Candidates who have qualified in NET-JRF or the UGC-CSIR joint tests.

Eligibility: Candidates who have qualified in NET-JRF or the UGC-CSIR joint test. However, the registration for the M.Phil/PhD is made by the Universities/Institutions/Colleges within stipulated period of two years from the date of declaration of result or date of issue of award letter/date of joining the fellowship. - **5. POST-MATRIC SCHOLARSHIP FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES:** The scheme is conducted by the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disability (DEPD) under Government of India in order to financially support disabled students studying in class 11 to Post-graduate degree or Diploma courses recognized by AICTE or UGC. Students with at least 40 percent disability with a maximum family annual income of INR 2.50 lakh (Two lakh fifty thousand) can apply for the scholarship scheme through the National Scholarship Portal. Beneficiaries will be granted with allowances for maintenance, book, and disability. - 6. CENTRAL SECTOR SCHEME OF SCHOLARSHIP FOR COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY STUDENTS (PM-USP CSSS): To provide financial assistance to meritorious students from poor families to meet a part of their day-to-day expenses while pursuing higher studies. The scholarships are awarded by Ministry of Education, Government of India on the basis of results of Higher Secondary / Class XII Board Examination. A maximum of 82,000 fresh scholarships per annum are provided for pursuing graduate / postgraduate degree in colleges and universities. ## **GUIDELINES FOR STAE LEVEL SCHOLARSHIPS**

- **1. ASPIRE SCHOLARSHIP:** Aspire Scholarship Program is the most prestigious scholarship program which is available by the Government of Kerala and various teaching departments present in Kerala state. This scholarship will be provided to the students who are currently pursuing post-graduation or Ph.D. degrees from affiliated colleges of the University Of Kerala. The selected candidates will be getting 8000 per month and 10000 per month, especially for the people doing internships outside Kerala state. - **2. SUVARNA JUBILEE MERIT SCHOLARSHIP:** It is offered by the Government of Kerala to the first-year UG and PG students of Kerala. The scholarship aims at supporting meritorious students from the financially weaker section of society to pursue higher education. Those selected for the scholarship will receive a reward of ₹ 10,000 per annum. The objective of the program is to motivate aspiring students to higher studies and a career in Science. Annual scholarship @ Rs. 12,000/-, Rs. 18,000/-, Rs. 24,000/- respectively for 1st, 2nd and 3<sup>rd</sup> years at U.G. level and @ Rs. 40,000/- & Rs. 60,000/- respectively for 1st and 2nd P.G. level. - **4. KSCSTE Science Research Scheme:** is an opportunity offered by the Kerala State Council for Science, Technology & Environment (KSCSTE) [an autonomous body under the Ministry of Science & Technology Government of Kerala] to the principal investigator (PI) and co-investigators (Co-Is) who are the regular faculty of research centres of colleges in the state of Kerala. The selected candidates will receive a research grant of INR 30 lakhs for a maximum duration of 3 years for the selected projects. - **5. VIJAYABHERI SCHOLARSHIP:** The SC/ST department offers Vijayabheri scholarship to students studying in plus two, degree, post graduation, polytechnic courses belonging to OBC, KPCR with annual income below 1 lakh. There is no income limit for SC/ST, OEC students for receiving fee concession. The students should apply online for the E grants from the Akshya Centers and the copy of the same along with income certificate, community certificate, copy of the savings bank passbook and Aadhar card should be submitted to the head of the institution. - 6. KERALA STATE HIGHER EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP: The very concept of instituting scholarships to meritorious students to pursue higher education was an offshoot of the declared motto of the Kerala State Higher Education Council; that is to bring about equity and excellence in higher education sector. Act 22 of 2007, by which the KSHEC was set up, empowers the council to evolve schemes for providing equitable opportunities for higher education through scholarships and free ships and financial assistance to the needy students. Invoking the foregoing provision of the Higher Education Council Act, a unique Higher Education Scholarship Scheme was framed and launched in 2009. 






assistance schemes of the Scheduled Castes Development Department. The beneficiaries of any educational assistance scheme have to first register by giving their basic details such as Name, Address, Date of Birth, Gender, Mobile Number, Bank Account details and Aadhar Number. Such registered students can apply through the same application for various schemes. Through a single registration, the system could uniquely identify a student and this basic detail shall be used for the disbursement of educational assistance throughout the period of education under various schemes. Provision for institutions will also be available for entering the applications, in case the student is not able to apply online. The financial assistance reaches the students bank account through Direct Beneficiary Transfer (DBT).

**K.P.C.R Concession:** The Govt. has awarded educational concession to the students belonging to socially and educationally backward classes in the forward community under Kumara Pillai Commission Report. At the time of admission if the student produces the income certificate in the prescribed form from the village officer within the income limit as given below, he/she will be exempted from paying tuition and special fee. Income limit Degree: Below Rs. 1,00,000 Post Graduate: Below Rs. 1,00,000 Immediately after admission they should obtain the prescribed application from the college office and submit the same duly filled in within the stipulated time. Students who enjoy the K.P.C.R. concession will have to produce the income certificate and the renewal application form for the succeeding academic year. 




# List with Eligibility Criterion of the Institutional Endowments and Scholarships

- 8. Rev. A amount of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) has been deposited (interest 7.5% per annum) at the District Co-operative Bank, Anchal for this purpose (Receipt No. 0355068, A/c. No. 14089 dated 28.03.2006). The interest accruing on this amount shall be equally distributed annually among the awardees. The interest of the amount will be credited to the SB Account No. 6983 operated by the Principal at the same bank. The selection of the eligible students shall be decided by a committee consisting of the two senior heads of the departments, staff adviser and staff secretary.
- 9. Rev. Fr. C.M. George Diamond Jubilee Endowment. This Endowment, instituted by Rev. Fr. C.M. George, Changarampallil House, Anchal, former principal, F.M.N. College, Kollam is awarded to nine first DC students who secure the highest marks in the I DC University Examination in each department. - 10. Dr. Sunny John Endowment for the student with higherst mark from III BSc Botany for University Examinations.












