Dept. of Commerce-Entrepreneurial Talk



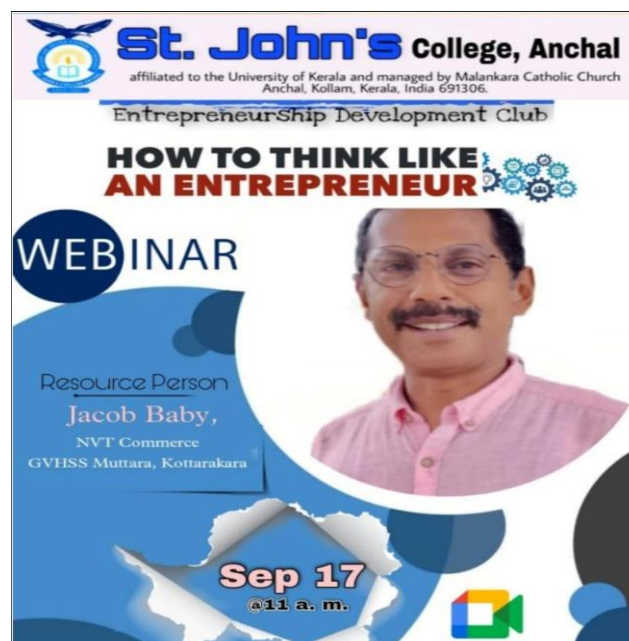
