- 5. The students of the department of English celebrated the 75th anniversary of Anne Frank's diary with individual and group presentations. Online posters were prepared for the event.








12.As part of "World Habitat Day," the Department of Economics convened a student seminar on the topic "Understanding Sustainable Development," on 11th October 2022.

15.As part of "World Poverty Eradication Day, 2022," the students of Economics department conducted the seminar "Discourse on Poverty in India" on 21 October 2022.




- 16. The Final Year students of BACE attended a short term micro teaching internship programme at St John's School, Anchal from November 07-11, 2022.






